**Parks Update**

- Little Community Libraries were installed at five Roseburg Parks thanks to a community-driven literacy project organized by Altrusa International of Roseburg. The little libraries were built by Joseph Lane Middle School eighth grade wood shop students and installed by Roseburg Parks & Recreation maintenance staff. You will find these little libraries located in Brown, Commercial, Eastwood, Laurelwood and Thompson Parks.
- The Halfshell cover in Stewart Park was severely vandalized in early September. A new cover has been ordered.
- The playground at Fir Grove Park was closed September 19th – 21st to allow time for a subcontractor to replace the poured-in-place rubber surface. This was warranty work performed on the very popular playground that opened in June 2018.
- New recreation program “Tapes-Trees in the Park” to debut summer 2023. Registration currently taking place. Please see attached flyer.
