





The Stewart Park large pavilion contains the following amenities: electricity, water and 28 picnic tables; 16 of the picnic tables are located on the east side and 12 on the west side. A large grassy area and playground are nearby.

Large Pavilion: All = \$150 - \$180 / Half = \$75 - \$90

A smaller pavilion containing 4 picnic tables is located on the hill above the bandshell adjacent to the restrooms.

Small Pavilion: \$50 - \$60

The Nichols bandshell is located near the South Umpqua River in Stewart Park. Electricity is available.

(rate available off season when the cover is down).
