**Apartment Complex Fire at 2460 W. Harvard Avenue**

Roseburg Fire Department responded to an apartment complex fire early this morning at 2460 W. Harvard Avenue. The fire was reported at about 5:00 AM when callers saw flames coming from windows in the five unit complex. Firefighters arrived within minutes to find the apartment complex significantly involved with flames, and four people were transported to Mercy Medical Center for evaluation and treatment.

Douglas County Fire District No. 2, Roseburg Police Department, Red Cross, Pacific Power and Avista Utilities assisted with the fire incident. Roseburg Fire Department investigators are currently working to determine the cause of the fire.

The Roseburg Fire Department would like to remind everyone that during the holiday season it is especially important to practice fire safety. Home heating and holiday decorations often pose hidden fire hazards, such as the use of decorative candles and electric space heaters. Be sure to keep combustibles clear of all sources of heat and fire, and keep small children and pets away from possible hazards.
