COVID-19 Phase 2 Reopening

Now that we are into Phase 2, most park amenities are open with some restrictions in place to reduce the spread of COVID-19. Playgrounds, the skate park, the splash pad, and sand volleyball courts have been opened back up. Organized sports have also been allowed to resume (with some restrictions). There are still limitations on group gatherings, which is why large events like Movies in the Park, Music on the Half Shell, and the Arts Festival were cancelled. We are pleased to be able to allow community members to resume recreational activities just in time for the busy summer season!

Projects Update

There have been no new developments on park capital projects since last month's update.

- Beulah has been delayed until spring 2021.
- The Stewart Park Pavilion Project will take place this fall.
- City staff submitted the RTP grant application for the Sunshine Trails Project, which was due on June 15th. We will not know if that application is successful until November.
- The new educational kiosk project at the Stewart Park Natural Area is moving along and should be completed by the end of summer.
