ITEM NO. 1 – BIDDING AND CONTRACT DOCUMENTS; PAGE 3 - ADVERTISEMENT FOR BID

On the first line of Paragraph 3, **REPLACE** the words:

“Bids are due by **2:00 PM** on March 2, 2021 ”

With:

“Bids are due by **3:00 PM** on March 4, 2021 ”

ITEM NO. 2 – BIDDING AND CONTRACT DOCUMENTS; PAGE 4 – INVITATION TO BID

REVISE the first paragraph, as shown below (**revision are in bold**):

The City of Roseburg will receive sealed bids or bids submitted via email marked "Bid for Project No. 19WA04, West Avenue Water Main Extension Project" until the hour of **3:00 p.m. on Thursday, March 4th, 2021**, at which time they will be publicly opened and read. When required by ORS 279C.370, bidders must submit a list of their first-tier subcontractors providing labor, or labor and materials, no later than **5:00 p.m.** that same day. Bids shall be addressed and delivered to Amy L. Sowa, City Recorder, City Hall, 900 SE Douglas Avenue, Roseburg, Oregon 97470, or emailed to info@cityofroseburg.org. Any and all bids received after the **3:00 p.m.** deadline for submission, or for which the list of first-tier subcontractors has not been submitted by **5:00 p.m.** that same day, shall be considered nonresponsive and returned to the bidder. All bidders must list their "Construction Contractors Board" or "State Landscape Contractors Board" license number as required by ORS 701.021 or 671.530 on the bid form.

ITEM NO. 3 – SPECIFICATION SECTION 33 11 10, WATER UTILITY DISTRIBUTION AND TRANSMISSION PIPING

On page 31 11 10 - 5, in Paragraph 1.5A - Materials, **REPLACE** Item No. 4 with the following:

4. All fittings and mechanical joint restraints shall be manufactured in the United States of America, except for those procured from Tyler Union, which may be provided as imported/non-domestic upon field acceptance by the Owner.
